

## KIEVE WAVUS EDUCATION

### Associate Health Center Director (Summer Camp Nurse, RN)

#### Summary

Our camp nurses care for the health and well-being of campers and staff as part of a collaborative health center team throughout the summer. Nurses are supported by the Health Center Director (RN), KWE's Healthcare Director (an on-site nurse practitioner), and a contracted consulting physician in town.

Our residential overnight camps run in two, 26-day-long sessions from mid-June to mid-August. The camp nurse joins the healthcare team to support the health and safety of approximately 250 campers (ages 8–16) across these two sessions at Camp Kieve or Wavus Camp.

#### Qualifications

This person must be a registered nurse with a valid driver's license and experience working with children or adolescents. Current BLS certification is required. This person should be punctual, reliable, patient, organized, and able to work collaboratively within a team in a summer camp setting.

#### Primary Responsibilities

##### *Clinical Care & Documentation:*

- Provide direct care for injured and ill campers and staff, including assessment and treatment.
- Lead daily health center operations and serve as a clinical resource for health center assistants and counselors, which includes documentation of healthcare encounters and communication of relevant health concerns to appropriate staff.

##### *Medications & Forms:*

- Administer daily and as-needed medications and prepare medications for wilderness trips.
- Support the intake, review, and organization of camper medical forms.
- Maintain organized medication systems.

##### *Emergency Response & Coordination:*

- Respond to emergencies as needed and support the implementation of Emergency and Crisis Response Plans.
- Consult with the Health Center Director and Healthcare Director and assist in coordinating care with outside medical providers when necessary.

##### *Team Collaboration:*

- Work closely with the Health Center Director and Healthcare Director and serve as a clinical resource for staff and counselors.
- Support communication with camp leadership and families when appropriate and help reinforce health and safety practices across the camp community.
