Primary Responsibilities

Healthcare | Communicate with visiting school staff and camper families about medical concerns. Work collaboratively to manage summer camp and employee healthcare forms. Help ensure that the Kieve and Wavus Health Centers are fully staffed and manage those spaces as needed. Maintain supply inventory and ordering system. Help implement standing medical orders and all healthcare and risk procedures and policies. Coordinate off-site medical care and communicate with families as needed. Oversee and ensure all medicine is safely stored and distributed for all programs. Facilitate all healthcare and risk staff training across programs.

Risk | Constantly assess operational risk associated with any programs or elements of the KWE campuses. Assist with coordinating external risk audits of KWE and help ensure compliance to state guidelines and protocols, as well as meeting industry standards. Coordinate any DHHS or other external inspections and support all follow-up. Monitor and ensure both campuses have up-to-date Emergency Response Plans, including effective distribution of Med Kits in shared spaces, Automatic External Defibrillators, and Epi-Pens. Lead training of employees on how to implement emergency response.

Documentation & Reporting | Help oversee and implement incident reporting and KWE Risk Management Team communications. Serve among staff who can receive Mandated Reports regarding Child Abuse and Workplace Harassment, including Sexual Harassment. Document all staff certifications in a timely manner.

Professional Development | Complete professional development to stay current in healthcare certifications and risk management best practices to best serve KWE, maintaining relationships with appropriate organizations.
