Work as the lead for Retreats, Events, and Rentals as needed, providing Level 2 support when appropriate. Be flexible to support a wide range of clients, ensuring each program is run as exceptionally as our school and summer camps.

Summer Camps

Serve in whatever capacity is needed. Typically this will be in an Assistant Director position, but could include trip leading as a Head Bunk Counselor. Live on campus to be a role model for summer camp staff and to be fully engaged in the life of camp.
