LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

S pringtime in Maine means mud season. And as messy as it is, mud season is always exciting for its promises of regrowth and possibility. At Kieve Wavus Education, the ice on Damariscotta Lake melted by April (a phenomenon called "ice-out" in Maine), our campuses were buzzing with The Leadership School students again by Patriots' Day (another New England springtime quirk), and final prep for summer camp is now well underway.

In last spring's edition of this letter, I wrote to you about imagining a future in which we share more of KWE's magic with new families and communities from near and far. This year, I'm proud to highlight some progress on that front.

As we strive to make KWE programs more accessible, this year we've provided more financial support to summer camp families than ever before.

This summer will also be the first we've partnered with A Thousand Summers, a Denver-based nonprofit with a mission to remove barriers — financial, socioeconomic and geographic — to wildernesstripping summer camps. We can't wait to welcome our first eight campers from A Thousand Summers in June.

We're also deepening our relationships with schools and community leaders from across the country who introduce Kieve and Wavus to kids who might not otherwise find their way to summer camp and who would thrive here. Our network is proactively recruiting amazing campers who choose Kieve or Wavus because of our community's encouragement and trust. Thank you for helping us grow this camp family!

During the school year, The Leadership School's pilot Teacher Certification Program has created a new pathway to help our educators become credentialed teachers in Maine. This innovative program aims to address significant teacher shortages across the state, ensuring local students benefit from KWE's dynamic, dedicated educators for generations. And knowing The Leadership School is well-positioned to make its greatest impact locally, we're focusing on expanding access for Maine's rural, under-served, and most diverse school communities in 2023–24.

Later in this newsletter, you'll read about how we opened our Kieve campus in March and April to host Boothbay's 7th and 8th graders while their school navigated some unexpected construction. Our amazing staff jumped into action to help our neighboring district, all while providing hundreds of meals every month to local pantries fighting against food insecurity. Both of these efforts began spontaneously in response to urgent needs in our Lincoln County home — a reminder that KWE's magic stretches beyond our transformative experiential programming.

All of these initiatives are the product of the collective care, commitment, and generosity of you, our beloved KWE community. Thank you for all you do to spread enthusiasm, ingenuity, and grit to the next generation.

GRETCHEN BRINKLER

The daughter of a local diner owner and a lobsterman, Gretchen grew up in Falmouth. Maine as the oldest of six kids. After graduating from the University of New Hampshire, she spent 1997 to 2002 working as an educator at The Leadership School and as a staff member at Kieve before earning her masters in school counseling at the University of Southern Maine. Now going on 20 years as a school counselor, currently at Bristol Consolidated School on Maine's Pemaquid peninsula, Gretchen credits KWE for steering her toward her destined path of caring

for and empowering students.

"I completed extensive course work and internship and practicum hours, but I can honestly say that none of that prepared me as much for the day-to-day work as what I learned in my years at KWE," says Gretchen. "I try to create lessons that are engaging and meaningful to students and deliver content in a way that gets kids moving and connects them to one another in genuine ways."

Gretchen now lives in Round Pond, Maine with her husband and three kids — a Wavus alum, a Wavus camper, and a son who will join Kieve this summer. She recognizes that just like she did while working at KWE, her girls have had some of the most amazing mentors of their lives in the counselors at Wavus. "So many of their best qualities — their social skills and big, kind hearts — were nurtured and strengthened by the people and experiences that Wavus provided."

Gretchen's first-hand experience at TLS and camp combined with her important work with local students and communities will be invaluable in advancing how KWE achieves its mission. ■

Guided by KWE's values of kindness, respect for others, and environmental stewardship, members of the board act as ambassadors, advisors, and governors of KWE, helping us strive for excellence and progress across our year-round experiential programs. The board's newest members — **Gretchen Brinkler** and **Reid Bolton**, who joined in 2023 — bring both history with and vision for KWE that are instrumental in advancing our mission.

REID BOLTON

Now a trial attorney in Chicago, Ill., Reid Bolton's connection to KWE began more than three decades ago — first as a camper from 1992–97, then as a counselor from 1999– 2001, then as an engaged alum with lifelong KWE friendships, and more recently as a Wavus parent since 2021.

Reid grew up in Miami and received his undergraduate degree at Harvard University and then his law degree at the University of Chicago. He credits Kieve for helping to shape him into the person he is today. "My favorite part of the work is trial, where there are six to eight people, all working hard together, with long days and nights and challenges every day. At the end, you come out the other side amazed that you were able to accomplish so much. Sound familiar?" says Reid.

Reid sees Kieve and Wavus as having a special formula for helping kids to learn about themselves and nature while they take healthy risks and conquer healthy challenges — a formula he wants to endure for the next generation.

"Our camps' greatest impact and potential is teaching children to believe in themselves and realize that kindness is a strength of character, not a weakness," says Reid. "I can think of so many times that the older, invincible counselors and directors of my childhood (Kaback, Casteen, Glidden, Richardson, Kennedy, the Mallozzi brothers, Palmer, Pesant, Wood, Lague, Labrie, LaCasse, and so many others) showed that grit, humor, and empathy were all part of being a great person."

STEWARDING OUR ENVIRONMENT AND COMMUNITY

WE is known for its transformational experiences, inspiring staff, and spectacular setting. To best serve our campers, students, and participants, we must always continue to steward our campuses and our environment well so that we can spend our next century changing lives. Here are some updates on projects currently under construction, and we look forward to updating you soon on the exciting initiatives ahead for Kieve and Wavus.

Systems Upgrade: KWE continues to proactively invest in protecting the health of Damariscotta Lake through our campus master plans. By summer 2023, Kieve will be home to a new, state-of-the-art leach field and pump station that mirrors Wavus's highly efficient system, augments Kieve's already extensive, carefully engineered systems, and gives us the ability to easily retire old fields when necessary. This upgrade ensures both campuses' wastewater systems can be easily expanded to support our future without risking harm to our lake.

New Solar Panels: Currently most of KWE's energy is supported by solar power with the exception of our two industrial kitchens. To ensure 100 percent of our energy is offset by renewable resources, we've begun the installation of a solar array, our third solar project, on the field west of the Wavus entrance, set to be complete in 2024.

New Staff Housing: Due to the remote and residential nature of our programs, our camp directors and TLS educators live in oncampus housing across Kieve

and Wavus. To better set our dedicated staff up for success and a sustainable work-life balance, we shuffled our work spaces over to the Annex this fall to transform the old office building back into staff housing. Fun fact: the former office used to be staff housing (where the Richardsons once lived!) so the renovation is fairly straightforward and should be complete by early 2024. So where do you come visit us when on campus? Our temporary office is in the Annex. Don't be shy!

Kennedy Learning Center Restorations: An integral part of our programs and a beloved KWE destination. construction to restore and improve the KLC was prioritized after two pipes burst in January 2022. The new KLC will feature a bigger, beautiful dining room; a renovated kitchen; an overhauled food services space; an expanded porch facing the lake for outdoor gatherings; upgrades to all rooms - expanding overall capacity and introducing three family-style suites: and an outdoor shower with a view of the lake. We look forward to hosting more guests, retreats, and events in this signature KWE space when doors open in 2024.

FEEDING OUR NEIGHBORS

ood insecurity is a reality for more than 12 percent of Lincoln County residents. And as one of the oldest counties in the state, many also face challenges preparing food. Since COVID-19 heightened this hardship, we've learned how to better serve our neighbors - leveraging our two industrial kitchens, year-round kitchen staff, vans, and eager staff to provide meals for those in need. From January through April 2023, we've delivered 3,000 meals and counting to Wiscasset, Jefferson, and Waldoboro pantries and continue to be responsive to evolving and spontaneous community needs.

This work began in 2020 in support of Healthy Lincoln

County (HLN), who identify under-resourced families and communities, and there is no end in sight for the partnership. KWE's Lee Giberson, Ellen Harrington, Megan Boyington, and Kristine Dyer have all worked closely with Marge Greenleaf and HLN Project Coordinator Jess Breithaupt to secure food from local organizations and prepare meals including the: processing of food purchased by KWE and provided by our partners; sourcing of additional ingredients by KWE to make complete, healthy meals; customization of foods and meals so they are accessible for individuals and populations with limitations (i.e. shredding or dicing vegetables for those without the dexterity to cut, removing food



from cans for those who can't use openers, soups for those with colder living conditions, meals that do not need to be refrigerated or heated for those without appliances, etc.); and packaging of meals for easy access.

Our aim to empower positive contributions starts in our local community, which empowers us in return.







BOOTHBAY REGION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CALLS KIEVE HOME

hen Boothbay Region Elementary School called us in early March with news that their facilities were unexpectedly unusable due to water damage that led to the uncovering of further necessary repairs, we were happy to open our doors to make sure that the students could continue to learn together in a safe environment. So in March and April while their buildings were being repaired, 7th and 8th graders joined us at Kieve. Suddenly, campus was bustling earlier in the year than usual as classes met in the Baldwin Art Center, Innisfree, Katahdin, and the Buck and students enjoyed that iconic Pasquaney view and lunch!

EDUCATOR-IN-RESIDENCE: A DAY IN THE LIFE

he Leadership School just wrapped up another successful Educatorin-Residence program, with our teachers serving in residence at local Midcoast schools for 20 weeks. The annual program enhances our teachers' professional development, expands local school's capacity — many in underserved communities — in the face of a teacher shortage, and enables more students to receive individualized support. This year saw 20 teachers in 26 schools, and the ripple effect was incalculable.

As a camper-turned-counselor-turned-staff-member, KWE's program coordinator and current TLS teacher **Will Bliss** put 15 years of KWE experience into serving his students at St. George in Tenants Harbor, Maine. Will is among the first to take advantage of The Leadership School's pilot Teacher Certification program — a collaborative solution to lower the barrier of entry for future educators in partnership with the University of Southern Maine and Southern Maine Community College. To help ensure that the cost of becoming certified is not an impediment, KWE is committed to covering all tuition for requisite coursework. Will plans to be certified by spring 2024 and to continue to make a difference right here in Maine.

TLS focuses on implementing KWE's experiential approach to socialemotional learning (EASEL) into local schools. "I have the privilege of leading students in activities focused on interacting. The learning is often hidden, and we work hard to coax it out. I like being the fun guy. But I also like diving in when they aren't having the best day. There is no better feeling in the world than when a kid asks you for help, we talk it out for a while, and they say thank you. That fills me up," says Will.

WEDNESDAYS WITH WILL

8 – 8:30 a.m.

EASEL Activity with 5th Graders: I lead a section of homeroom once a week that includes a check in on how the week is going and then kicks their day off with an EASEL activity. Today we played "helium hoop" where each student needs to keep a finger on a hula hoop as the whole class lowers it to the ground.

8:30 – 9 a.m.

Open: Typically I spend this break in my schedule in the gym shooting hoops with the middle-level grades during their Unified Arts block.

9 – 9:40 a.m.

EASEL Activity with 7th Graders: Today we played Code Breakers. I break the class into two teams, and a representative (codebreaker) from each group studies a series of playing cards that I have laid out. Next, without using words or charades, they have to communicate with their group in an effort to get the rest of the group to match the sequence using their own deck of cards. It encourages self management, communication skills, teamwork, and managing competitiveness!

9:40 – 10:40 a.m.

Social Studies with 8th Graders: Some days student-teaching means teaching lessons but often, like today, I am there to support the teacher and help out students while they do independent work. Today we kicked off a unit on geography. Students took online quizzes to refresh their knowledge, and I challenged them to head to head matchups!

10:40 – 11:40 a.m.

K/1 Lunch and Recess: Once a week I help supervise Kindergarten and 1st grade lunch and recess always a treat. Today I kept order on the sledding hill!

11:40 a.m. – 12:40 p.m.

Lunch and Recess: As the weather warms up the baseball gloves come out. It is a great time to encourage students to connect outside of the classroom to make lasting connections.

12:40 – 1:20 p.m.

Prep Period: It's always changing based on the varying needs of students. Today I enjoyed my lunch while leading a reading group for students who needed to catch up with the rest of the class.

1:20 – 2:30 p.m.

One-on-one Sessions: I regularly meet with several students that


have been identified by the school as those who would benefit from extra support. We establish trust, set goals, and chat about life as a way to build skills to achieve these goals. Today we played chess and discussed their goals before leaving for high school.

2:30 – 4 p.m.

Afterschool Program aka "Forest School": I lead explorations of the trail marshland behind the school with 2nd and 3rd graders. We play EASEL games, tromp around on the icy marsh, go sledding, and today we all worked together to build a fort. It's always nice to end the day outside!


