Primary Responsibilities

Buildings, Property

Work autonomously at any of our four midcoast campuses to ensure all KWE property – whether a building, dock, or boat – is maintained to the highest standard. Whether repairing things that break, pre-empting wear, or identifying issues that require contractor support, lead staff is responsible for proactively identifying problems before they happen and being responsive to issues that arise. A positive attitude, excellent work ethic, and willingness to learn new skills. On call for emergencies after hours, on weekends, or holidays.

Grounds

Do whatever is required to maintain the grounds on our four campuses. From mowing lawns and weed wacking, to fertilizing and trail clearing, our campuses are diverse and require a variety of skill sets to meet the different standards of our programs. Coordinate with contractors and proactively look for ways to maintain the health of our space so that we protect our lake and broader environment. Be on call for weather events, especially for plowing and winter ice and snow removal.

Operations & Risk

Work closely with the Hospitality Director, Food Services Director, and all Program Directors to ensure that issues are identified before they become significant and so that all programs operate in spaces that are highly functioning and meet an appropriate standard of cleanliness. Support our compliance to Federal, State, and DHHS standards and report operational risk to our Healthcare & Risk Director when seen.
