Secure a Level 1 Challenge Course certification and complete other training as needed. Mentor and guide each cohort of TLS Fellows to develop skills that will allow them to be successful at TLS and in their future career - whether in education or another field.

Retreats & Events

Support the facilitation of Retreats and Events as needed, providing Level 1 support when appropriate. Be flexible to support a wide range of clients, ensuring each program is run as exceptionally as our school and summer camps.

Summer Camps

Serve in whatever capacity is needed. Typically this will be in an Assistant Director position, but could be as a Head Bunk Counselor. Be a role model for summer camp staff and be fully engaged in the life of camp.

Operations & Risk

Available to support Maintenance & Facilities, Hospitality, and Food Services however needed to ensure that KWE is able to function at the highest level possible. Lead all programs through the lens of healthy risk-taking, striving to provide an environment where participants can be challenged safely.
